### Suggested Junior High/High School Supply List

- ❖ Backpack (With computer padding for 9-12 grades)
- ❖ 8 Notebooks **OR** a 3 subject notebook and 3 single subjects
- ❖ 8 Folders
- ❖ MANY pencils and pens
- ❖ A calculator that does fractions (TI-30XA or TI-30XIIS are a few good ones) \*\*A scientific calculator is a good investment for all 7-12 math classes
- ❖ 9-12 Math classes- graph paper
- ❖ Locker rack (recommended, not required), preferably one with legs, not plastic "shelf" (new lockers are wider than the old ones)
- ❖ Clothes and shoes for all 7-12 PE classes
- ❖ **Additional items may be needed at the request of teachers throughout the year**
- ❖ The following is a list of teachers and specific classes and supplies. If your child is not in one of these classes or with a particular teacher, you do not need to purchase the supplies.

Mrs. Peters	6-8: journal/composition notebook, pencils, erasers, markers, colored pencils, glue, assignment notebook 10 and Basic English: journal notebook, pencils
Mrs. Carlson	7-8 Science: colored pencils, book cover, recipe/notecard box, 150 notecards (small)
Mrs.Hagen	6 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> Choir: Pencils, water bottle
